HYGGE HOME COASTER



"Hygge" – Danish word for a mood of coziness and comfortable feelings of wellness and contentment.

Crochet Pattern

MATERIALS

- US H/5mm hook, or hook needed to obtain gauge.
- Worsted Weight (category 4) cotton yarn. Approximately 25 yards. I used Knit Picks Dishie yarn.
- Scissors.
- Measuring Tape.
- Tapestry needle for weaving in ends.

GAUGE

HEIGHT: 8 MBST (including CH1) = 2"

WIDTH: 7 MBST rows = 2"

TERMINOLOGY

-This pattern uses standard US crochet terms-

- CH = Chain
- MBST = Mini Bean Stitch
- Rep = Repeat
- SK = Skip

- St = Stitch
- Sts = Stitches
- SL-ST= Slip-Stitch
- YO = Yarn Over

APPROXIMATE FINISHED SIZING


Measurements taken with dish towel laid flat, before wear or stretching

SIZE	TOTAL LENGTH	TOTAL WIDTH
ONE SIZE	4.5"	4.5"

PLEASE READ BEFORE STARTING: NOTES

- *OVERVIEW: Coaster is worked from the bottom-up using MBST. Pattern provides instructions for one size. Finished measurements as written provided above.
- *ADJUSTMENTS: adjust length by doing more or fewer rows. Adjust width by adding or subtracting to your initial CH in increments of 2.
- *ALWAYS CH 2 TOTAL at the beginning of each row.
- *BEGINNING CHAIN 2 NEVER counts as the first stitch.
- *STRIPES OR SOLID: Pattern instructions are for a solid coaster. Get creative with your color combinations! Perfect for stash-busting. For the striped example, I divided the 14 rows by 2 which allowed for 7 colors. I had 6 colors, so I used one for the bottom and top 2 rows. I cut my yarn after each color join.
- *YARN: I used Knit Picks Dishie (cotton) for this towel. Comparable yarns include: Lion Brand Re-Up, Premier Home Cotton Cone, Lion Brand 24/7 Cotton, and Hobby Lobby I Love This Cotton! *NOTE:* Any cotton blend worsted weight (category 4) yarn may be used for this project.
- *"V" SPACE FOR MBST: For each row (after the initial CH row) you will insert your hook into the "V" directly next to the previous row's MBST. DO NOT insert it underneath your CH1 from previous row.

MINI BEAN STITCH (MBST) EXPLAINED

- NOTE: Work all steps into the same stitch. Keep loop tension loose, not tight on hook.
- **Step 1:** Insert hook into stitch, YO and pull through (2 loops on hook).
- **Step 2:** YO, insert hook into same stitch, YO and pull through (4 loops on hook).
- **Step 3:** YO, pull through all 4 loops.

WRITTEN PATTERN

START/Round 1: CH 21. MBST into 3rd CH from hook. *CH 1, SK next CH, MBST into next CH*. Rep from * to * across. (10 total MBST, 10 CH1 sts).

Rows 2-14: CH2 and turn. MBST in "V" space next to previous row's MBST (see NOTES section for "V" space visual). *CH 1, SK next CH, MBST into next "V" space*. Rep from * to * across.

OPTIONAL HANGING LOOP: after last round, CH 6. SL-ST into first CH. SL-ST again into base of last worked MBST.

FINISHING

- -Cut yarn.
- -Using your tapestry needle, weave in all loose ends.
